

## AIM-AHEAD FHIR Collaborative **Training Program**



**Program Overview** 

The AIM-AHEAD FHIR (Fast Healthcare Interoperability **Resources) Collaborative Training Program** will train a multidisciplinary cohort from academia, industry, healthcare, and community organizations to accelerate and sustain adoption of FHIR across clinical and research environments.

FHIR is a modern, widely implemented standard for representing and exchanging healthcare data across health IT systems. By normalizing data access, FHIR enables reusable pipelines and applications for research, quality improvement, public health, and operational analytics.

The program will build a national network of FHIR champions – researchers, clinicians, software developers, informaticists, and other healthcare professionals forming a well-trained cohort capable of appropriately using FHIR to advance basic, clinical, social, and behavioral science

There are three tracks for the AIM-AHEAD FHIR Collaborative Training Program, and all learning will be 100% online. Only Track 3 participants are expected to attend the in-person AIM-AHEAD conference in July 2026.

## **Award Details**

Track 1

\$1,000 stipend upon completion of Track 1 training

Track 2

\$4,000 stipend disbursed in two installments.

Track 3

\$8,000 stipend disbursed in two installments, and a \$2,000 travel allowance to cover travel expenses to attend the AIM-AHEAD Annual Meeting in July 2026.

Note: Stipend payments are awarded based on the completion of required program milestones.
