AIM-AHEAD is recruiting **coaches** for the **2025–2026 AIM-AHEAD FHIR (Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources) Collaborative Training Program**. The purpose of this program is to train a multidisciplinary cohort from academia, industry, healthcare organizations, and community-based organizations to accelerate and sustain FHIR adoption across healthcare and research settings.

Selected coaches will support trainee progress through regular meetings, provide guidance for professional development, and help trainees align their projects with program objectives. However, they are not expected to provide technical FHIR instruction, design research methods, or make implementation decisions.



Eligibility Criteria

Coaches should have multidisciplinary expertise to ensure trainees benefit from a range of perspectives, real-world insights, and professional norms that enhance their development. This may include, but is not limited to, individuals from healthcare and allied health, informatics, software engineering, physical and life sciences, mathematics, statistics, or data science, engineering, social sciences, and health and population sciences.

Applicants must hold a MA/MS, PhD, MD, or equivalent qualification (e.g., PharmD, DNP, DrPH) and be affiliated with a U.S.-based organization. They must reside in the U.S. during the program period (February–July 2026) and be able to submit a W-9 through PaymentWorks. Eligible organizations include academic, healthcare, industry, nonprofit, community, or faith-based institutions.

Note: Individuals with conflicts of interest with AIM-AHEAD, current AIM-AHEAD trainees, and individuals serving as mentors or coaches in other AIM-AHEAD programs are not eligible to apply. AIM-AHEAD MPIs may serve as coaches but are not eligible to receive the coach stipend.

Coaches will support **1 trainee** each and will be compensated a total stipend of **\$1,000** for their time dedicated. Only Track 3 trainees will be paired with a coach.
